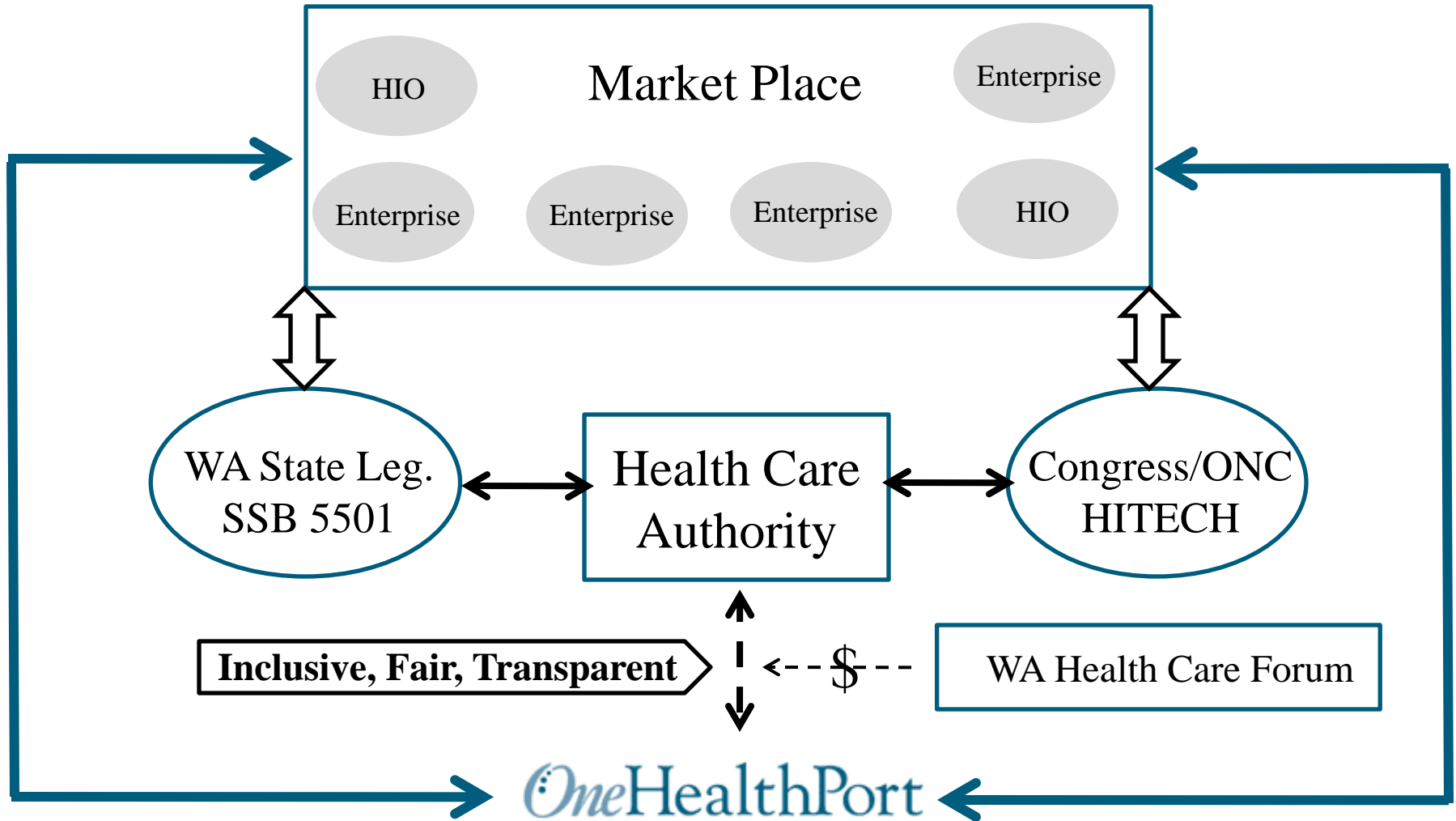

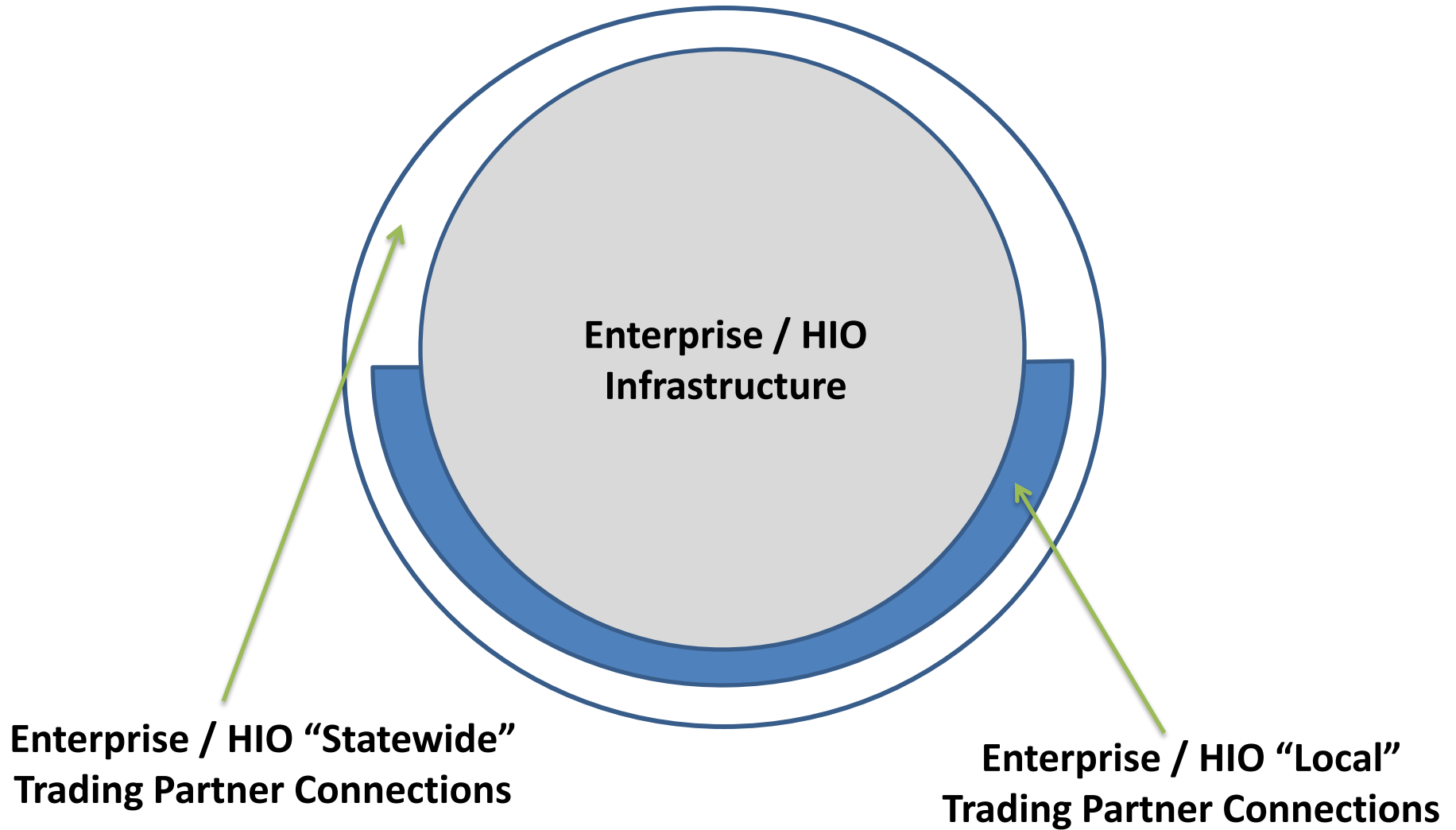

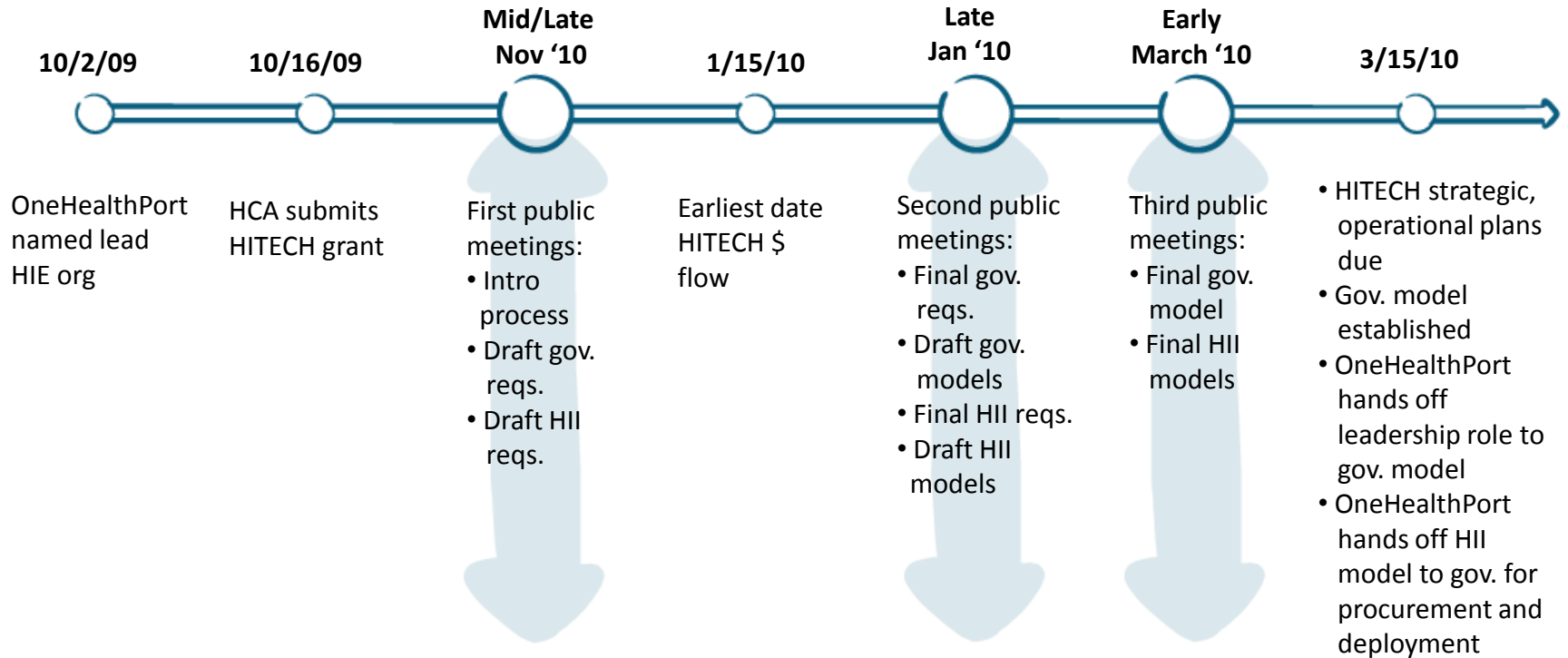
Objectives

- Between 10/2/09 and 3/15/10 our focus is on three objectives:
 1. Complete the required Strategic and Operational Plans to secure HITECH funding
 2. Identify and establish the preferred stakeholder governance model for HIE in Washington state
 3. Design the shared elements of the health information infrastructure needed to enable HIE in Washington state
- Ideally, by 3/15/10 OneHealthPort and HCA hand over HIE leadership to new Governance model

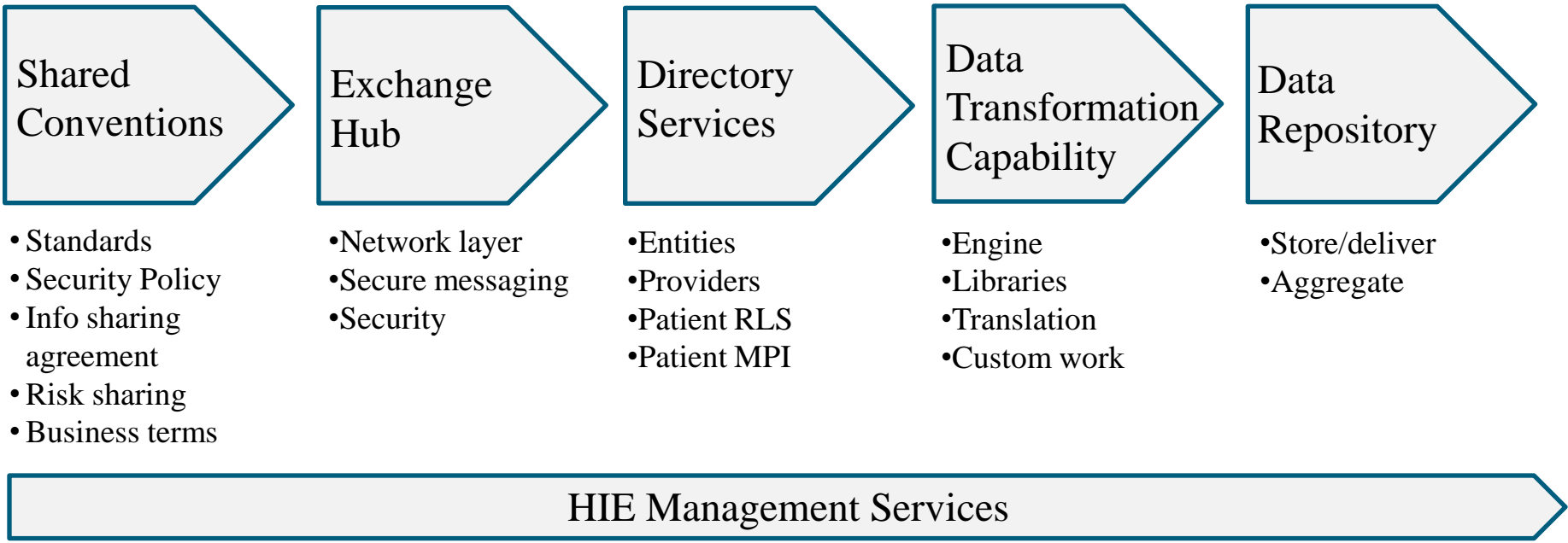
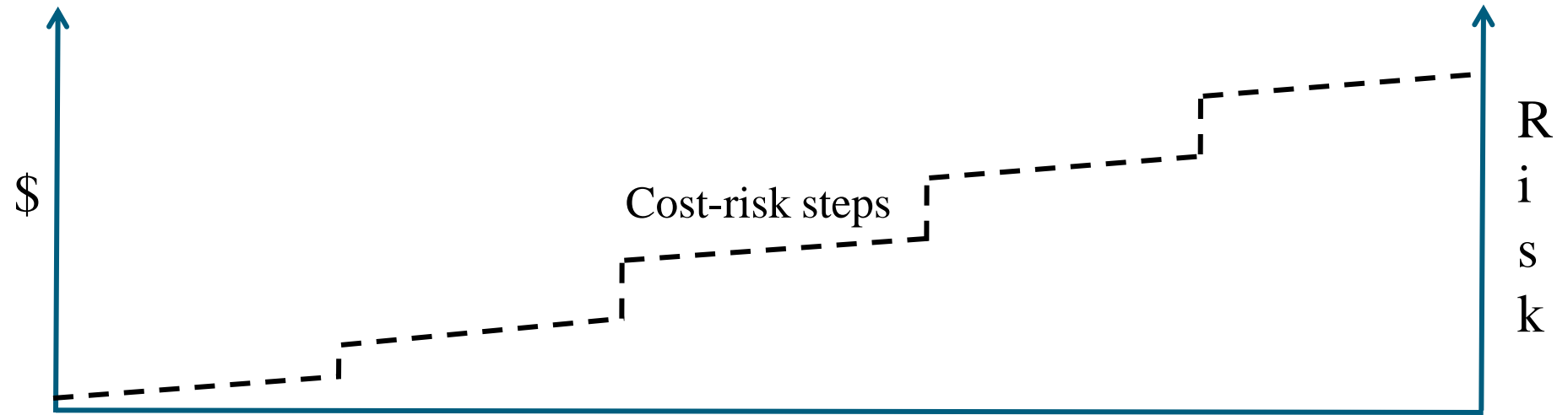
